Sharpen Diamond Tools - As Easy As It Gets ...

At the International Wood Technology Fair Xylexpo in Milan Lach Diamant introduced an universal sharpening machine program which simplifies the servicing - sharpening of diamond tools.

This success is based on the discovery of spark erosion by Lach in 1978 where the erosion processing for polycrystalline synthetic diamonds finally led to the worldwide introduction of diamond tools for the processing of wood and wood-like materials.

Despite the long service life (up to several months) of the diamond cutting edge, the moment for this hardest cutting material arrives where the performance decreases. It becomes dull and has to be resharpened.

Now the time has come for the CNC universal sharpening machine »Dia-2100-mini« developed primarily for the resharpening



service. Diamond tools and saws can be sharpened quickly, precisely and economically.

With the development of the »mini shows profile« program package, the manufacturer has added yet another highlight. Thanks to a contrived new program for CNC continuous track control there are now three possibilities for the production of profile tools available to the user.
